



Ordinance No. O2015-10-004

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOGALES, ARIZONA, AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 10 :FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION" BY REPEALING SECTION 10-1 "CODES ADOPTED" AND ADOPTING NEW SECTION 10-1 ADOPTING FIRE CODES AND STANDARDS BY REFERENCE. (LEGAL)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Nogales, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: Nogales City Code Section 10-1 "Codes adopted." is hereby repealed.

Section 2: New Section 10-1 is hereby adopted, which shall read as follows:

Sec. 10-1. Codes and Standards.

(a) The 2012 International Fire Code and Appendices except for Appendix J and the latest editions of the National Fire Protection Association Codes and Standards, except for Standard 1, three copies of which are on file with the City Clerk, are hereby adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein as the City's Fire Codes and Standards.


Section 3: All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days from enactment.

Section 5: In the event any provision in this ordinance is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions in this ordinance shall be deemed severable and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6: The City Clerk is directed to publish the text of this Ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation for two (2) consecutive weeks after its effective date, and further to post a copy of this Ordinance in three (3) or more public places within the City.



STAFF SUMMARY

Subject: Adopting updated uniform Fire Codes and Standards

Background: Current City Code Section 10-1 states that "the latest and most recent" Uniform Fire Code and Standards are adopted. By Ordinance No. O99-09-06, the 1997 National Fire Code was expressly adopted.

Due to the need to update the City's Fire Codes and Standards, the proposed ordinance expressly adopts the 2012 International Fire Code by reference, three copies of which are on file with the City Clerk. In addition, the National Fire Protection Association publishes standards that are a consensus in the fire protection industry on very specific topics, such as how to test and inspect fire prevention equipment and other standards.

Many jurisdictions amend the standard codes by amending or deleting specific provisions that are not applicable to local circumstances. Please see the "2015 Additions and Deletions to City Fire Codes and Standards" that amends the above codes.
